WHAT IS EXPLORING THE CONSTRUCTION TRADES?

DETAILS OF THIS PROGRAM

- ✦ This three credit Construction program provides students from all five secondary schools with an opportunity to explore **Construction Careers** while gaining safety training and basic skill development in specific skilled trades.
- ✦ A Conestoga instructor will deliver the instruction in each area. A secondary school teacher will be responsible for supporting the students and helping them to achieve these secondary school credits.
- ✦ Transportation to the College will be arranged through the School/College/Work Initiative (SCWI).
- ✦ The cost of tuition and textbooks will be covered.
- ✦ The cost of safety boots and safety glasses will be covered up to a maximum of \$100 per student.
- ✦ This program will run dependent on sufficient enrolment. Specific trades offered may be subject to change due to availability of College facilities and an instructor.
- ✦ Course codes: TSE4TQ, TLA4TQ and TSM4TQ
- ✦ The program is offered during Semester 1 only.
- ✦ Co-op is included in this program. The co-op component will be either one or two credits.
- ✦ Your Co-op teacher will find your placement. Parents and students **MUST NOT** set up their own contacts with employers.
- ✦ Students that have already earned their OSSD and graduated are ineligible to apply.
